

Agripreneur Assignment #1: Create a Map of your High Tunnel

For this assignment, you will create a map of your high tunnel and plan out where your crops will be planted. If you have a fellow Agripreneur student, please work together. You only need to make one map for your high tunnel!

You will need:

- A tape measure
- Graph paper, pencil, and ruler (or a computer program that will let you make a “to-scale” layout)

1. Measure your high tunnel, and then draw a “to-scale” map of your growing space. Include all beds in the high tunnel, even if you will not be growing in them.

2. Make a couple of copies of your map, so that you have blank copies for the future.

3. What will go in the high tunnel? Talk with your liaison to determine what crop varieties will be in the space.

4. Layout a plan for your plants on your map. Check out your seed varieties and figure out how far apart each variety needs to be planted from others. Put an **X** where each plant will go, using different colors for different varieties and labelling them.

1. How many plants will fit in each row?
2. How many plants will fit in the high tunnel? (Just in the rows you are able to use, not the whole high tunnel.)

Please add this information to your map!

5. Label your map with your names and your school. We only need one map per school, so remember to work together!

6. Decide on the date you will plant your seeds – it must be no later than June 1st, 2016. Add your expected planting date to your map.
